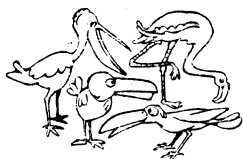

BE ON FILE

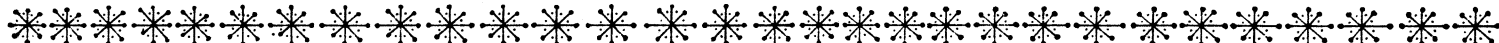
