Travel Light, Take Great Pictures

Join Katrin Eismann, Sony Artisan, as she takes us along on her travels around the world to photograph in Chile, Cuba, Germany, Tasmania and Zimbabwe. Katrin will address how for her; less equipment makes for better photographs, why it's important to not listen to the nagging critic in your head, and how experimentation and previsualization of digital post processing makes her a better photographer. Additionally, Katrin will show some of her favorite image processing tips and techniques.

Katrin Eismann is an internationally respected artist, teacher, and author and is the founder and chair of the Master's in Digital Photography department at the School of Visual Arts in New York City. She is the coauthor of *Photoshop Restoration & Retouching, Photoshop Masking & Compositing, The Creative Digital Darkroom* and *Real World Digital Photography*.
