
Join John for this uplifting lecture that will leave you inspired to stay true to and honor your vision, creating images that make your heart sing.


Please submit your 3 Members' Night photos and/or images of John by June 23 to sierraphotonyc2@gmail.com. See the instructions on the following page.

Preparing your Photos for Members' Night

1. Select up to 3 of your nature-themed images.
2. Format each image as a JPEG file, sRGB format at 72 pixels per inch, with 1280 pixels on the long side. Export your images so that each image does not exceed 1 MB in size, to fit all photos in a single email. Most people first export their images to their computer desktop from their image processing software, then attach them to the email.
3. Label each image with your name and a sequential number, such as: Jones_Mary#1.jpg. Use the sequence in which you would like to have the photos shown. Make sure that when you join via Zoom, you use the same name so that we can announce your photos.
4. Email ALL photos (whether they are related to John's memorial or are your own nature images) to: sierraphotonyc2@gmail.com. If you need to send more than one email, indicate this in the subject lines ("Members' Night Photos #1", "Members' Night Photos #2").
5. We plan to feature some of our Members' Night photos on the sierraphotonyc.com website. A committee will select one photo from each contributor. By submitting photos, we will assume that you have granted permission to post one of your photos on our website. If you do NOT want a photo posted, please indicate this in your submission email.
